RECYCLING & UPCYCLING

This year's festival will have a recycling depot, please be conscious of which bin you are using. Separate your items into three groups:


COMPOST & ORGANIC WASTE

Everything organic will be fed to the pigs at a farm nearby.

Please bring a container (eg: an old ice cream container) and keep your organic waste in it until you get to the sorting depot where you will find organic waste buckets.


RECYCLABLES

NON-RECYCLABLES

Ecobrick it! These are the items that would otherwise end up in landfill.


Items such as chips and sweet wrappers, cling wrap, foil and cigarette butts should get stuffed into any size plastic bottle, these will be used as insulating building bricks to use in an eco-building project in the future.

FOLLOW THESE EASY STEPS!



1) BRING A LIDDED BUCKET OR CONTAINER

EG: a tupperware or ice cream container. Keep your organic waste in here and take to our compost buckets when it's full.



2) BRING YOUR OWN CUTLERY, PLATES AND CUPS

The less packaging the better! Rather choose a reusable set made from wood, ceramic, tin or recyclable plastic, than a single use option. This means less waste and a loving impact!



3) BRING YOUR OWN WATER BOTTLE

It's going to be hot! You'll need to stay hydrated and drink lots of water, but you don't need more than one bottle. Bring a strong bottle that you can refill over and over again.



4) BRING ONLY BIODEGRADABLE SOAPS & TOOTHPASTE

Your waste water returns to the land. Please be mindful of the products you are using and be sure they are biodegradable. The wash stations will be equipped with Better Earth and Shop Zero biodegradable dishwashing and hand washing soaps.
